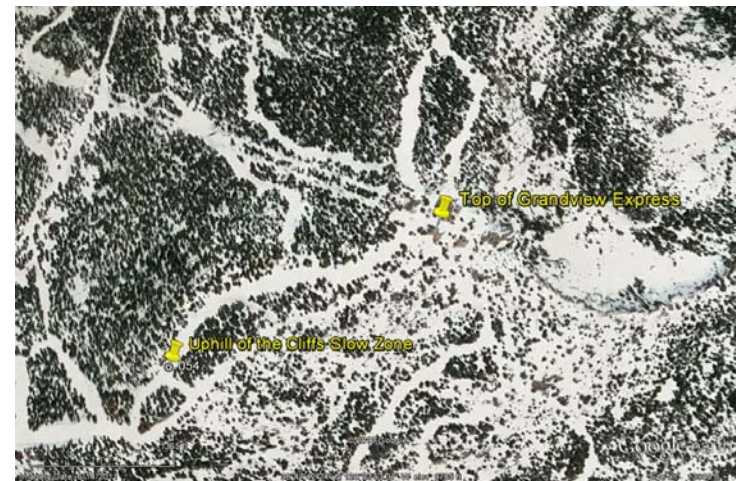




The 'Wampa Cave' arch entrance a short distance down from the summit on left side of Sugar & Spice.



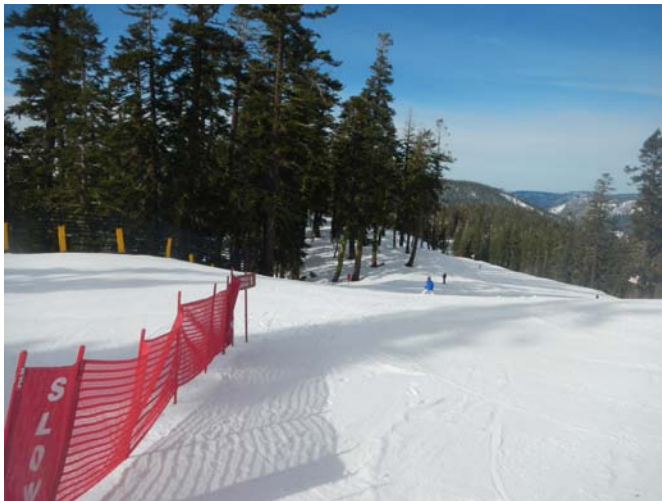
Uphill of the 'Ledges' Slow Zone on Sugar & Spice.

The 'Barnyard' Area at the intersection of Sugar & Spice and Lower Snowshoe.



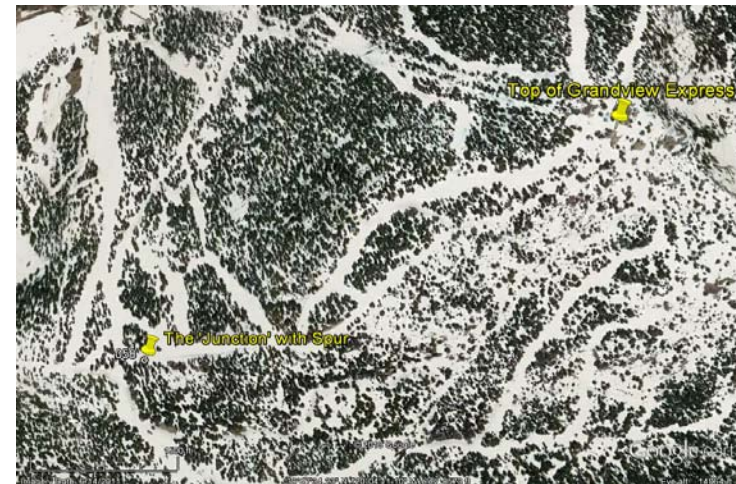




Top end of 'Tortilla' or 'Tijuana' Flats on Sugar & Spice just beyond the entrance to Upper Jackrabbit on right side of trail.

The 'Cutover' or 'Split' with Upper Main on left and Sugar & Spice on right

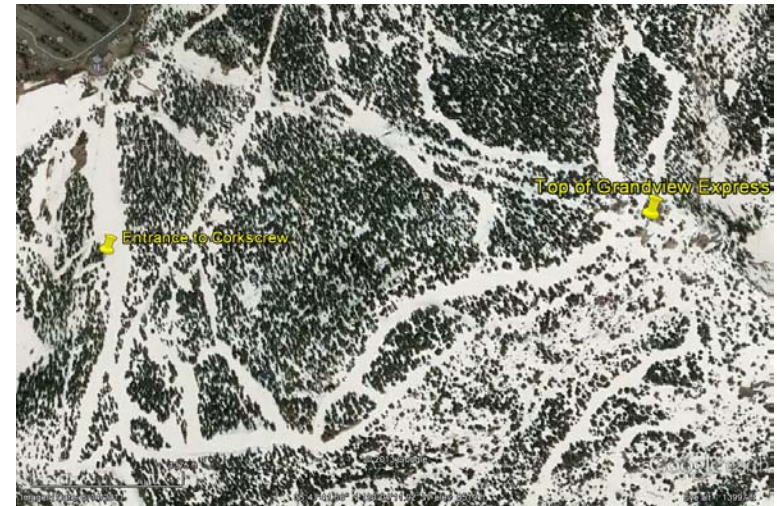


Lower portion of Upper Main looking toward lip where Lower Main and Corkscrew begins on left side.

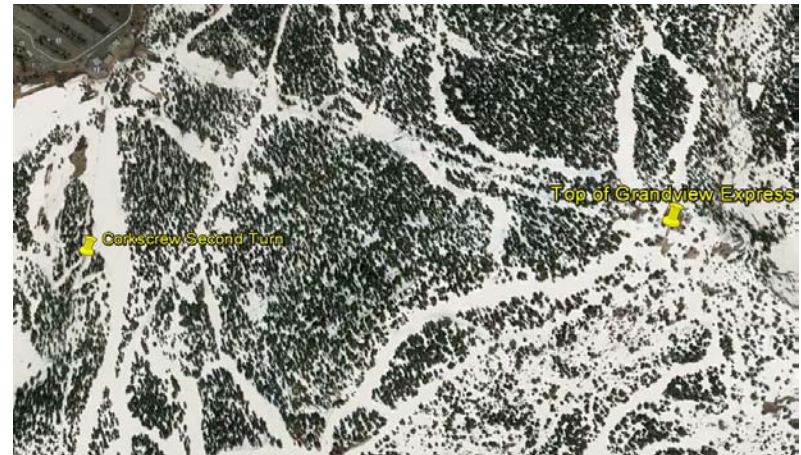




Entrance to Corkscrew looking toward the first turn



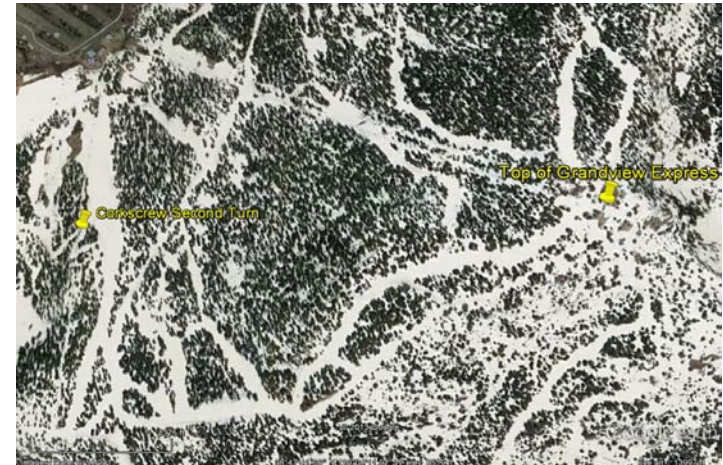
Mountain Host Post location at second turn on Corkscrew. Note dangerous entrance from Lower Main on right side.



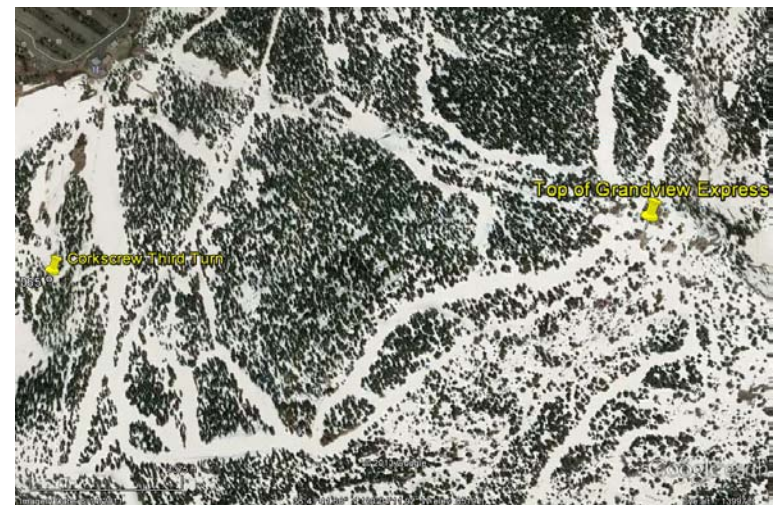




**Corkscrew view from Second Turn looking toward the Third Turn**



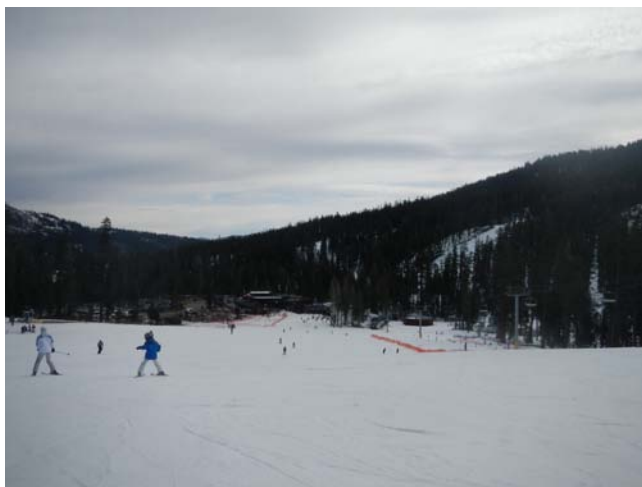
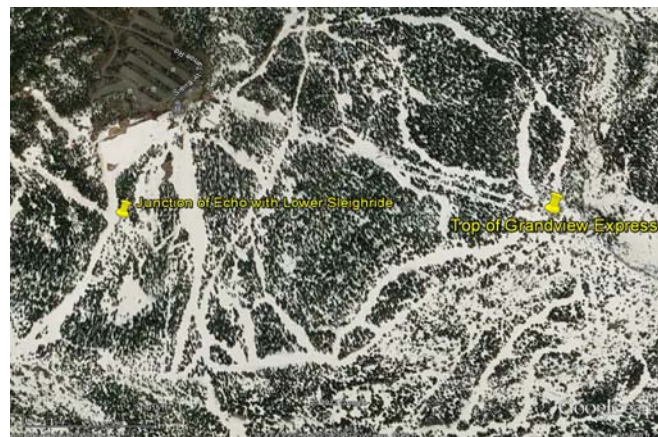
**At the end of Corkscrew, view from Third Turn looking at the top of the Rock Garden Lift and beginning of Echo**

Top of Broadway looking at Base Lodge Area with Easy Rider Express Lift on right side and Feature Park beyond.



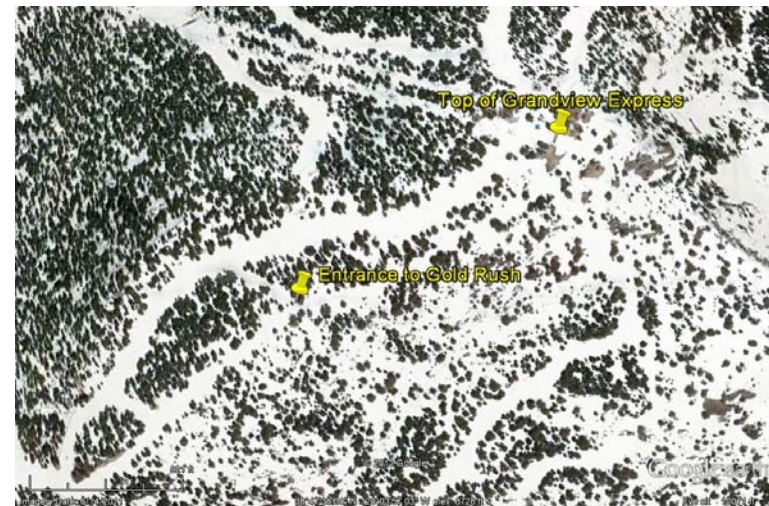




Entrance to the Upper Snowshoe Feature Park.

Entrance to Black Bart Adventure Trail



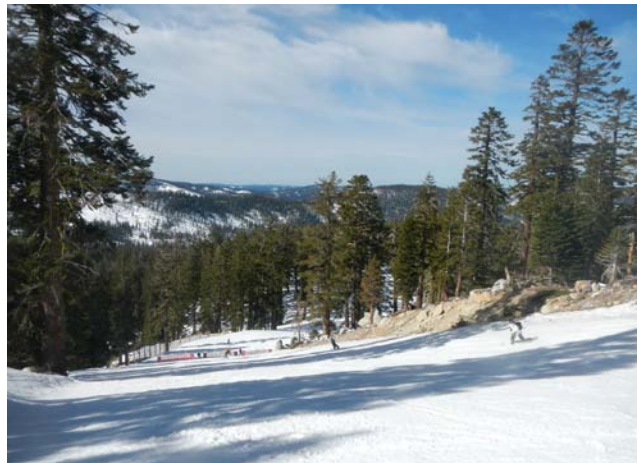
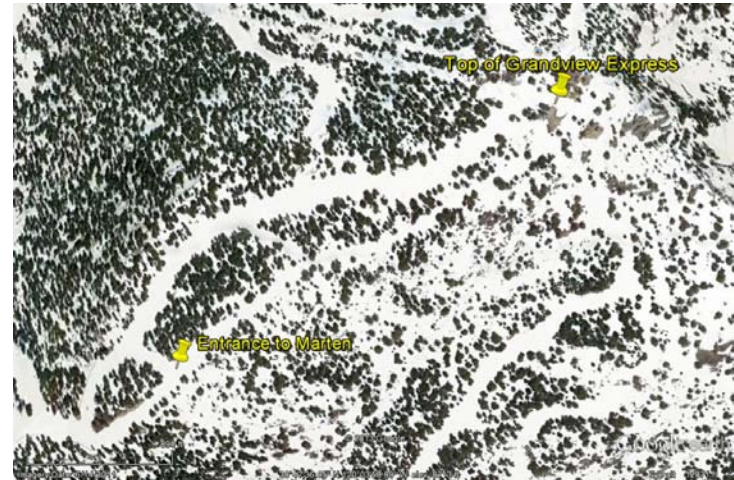
End of the Black Bart where it terminates at Sugar & Spice just above the 'Ledges' Slow Area.







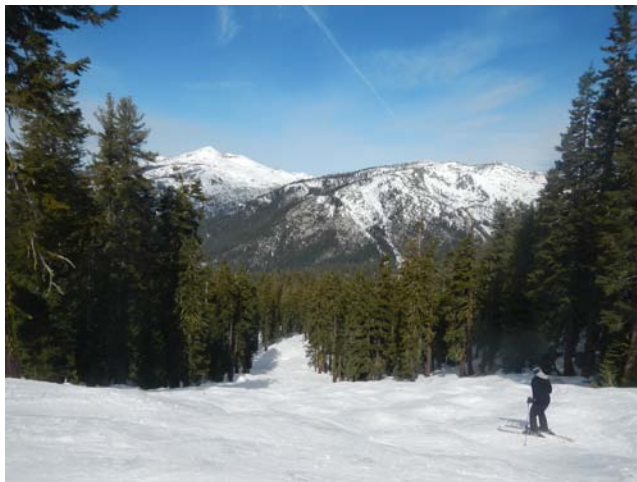
Entrance to Marten from Upper Snowshoe. It connects to Sugar & Spice, which is visible at far side.



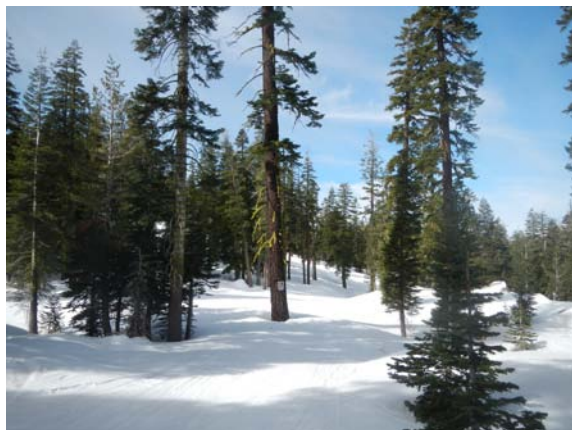
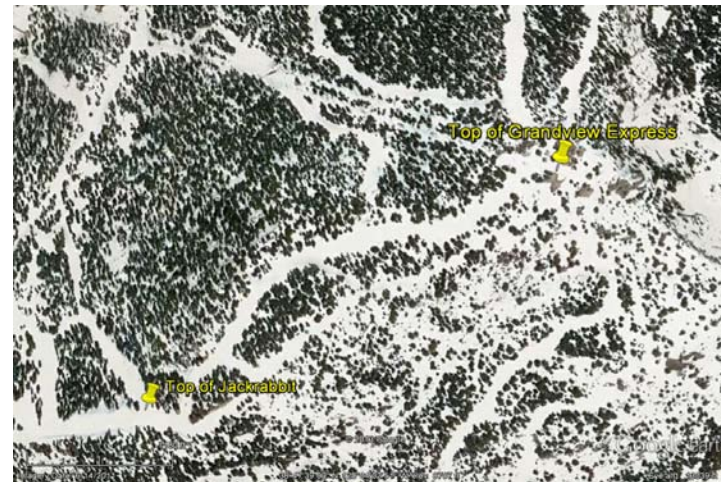
Lower Snowshoe looking toward the 'Barnyard' and merge with Sugar & Spice







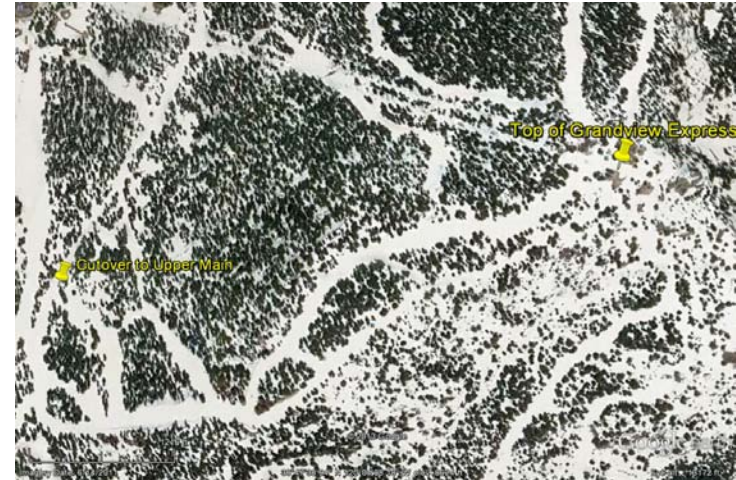
Top of Jackrabbit from right side of Sugar & Spice just below the 'Barneyard' (also known as "Concern Corner")



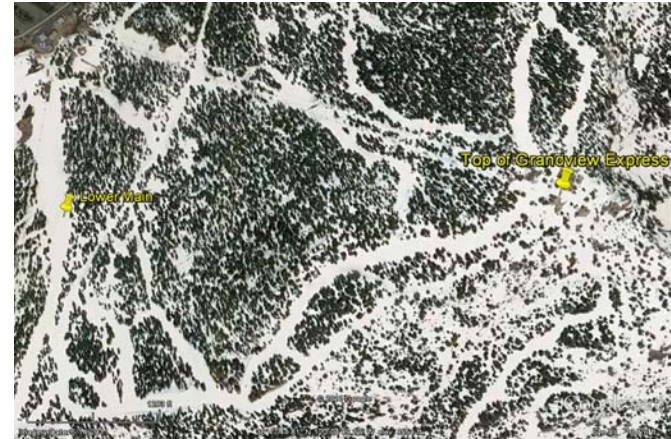
Bottom of Jackrabbit looking to merge with bottom of Hemlock and Sugar & Spice beyond that.





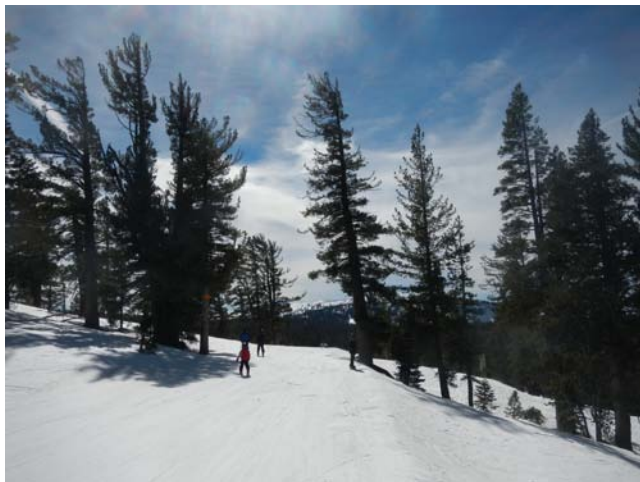


Ego is the cutover to Upper Main from Sugar & Spice opposite from merger with bottom of Hemlock.

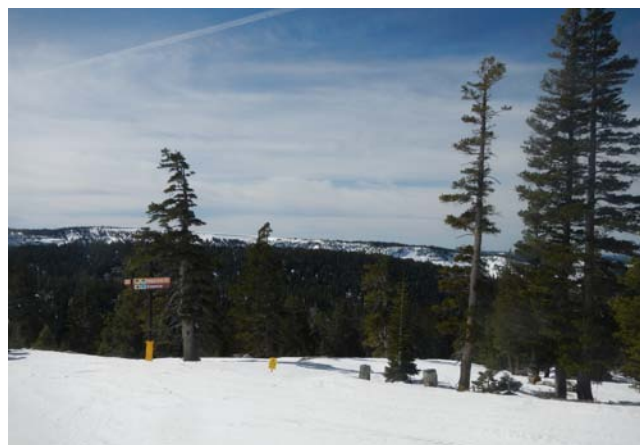


Lower Main from crest looking toward Base Lodge Area.





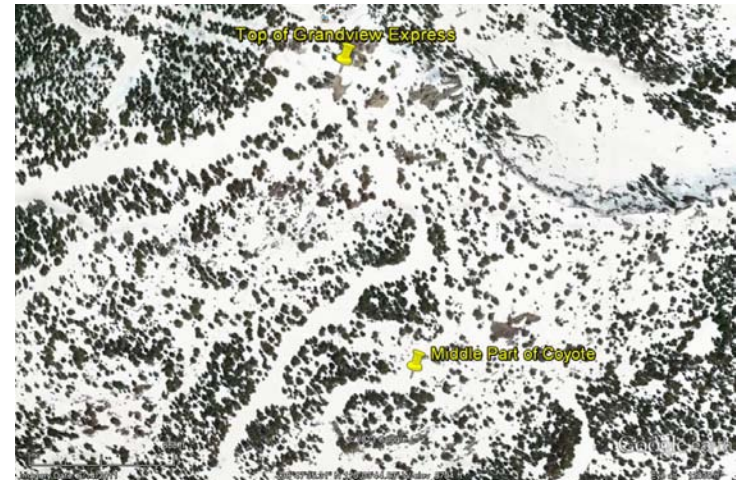
Top portion of Wagon Trail on the Backside.

The "Narrows" on Wagon Trail just beyond Coyote entrance.



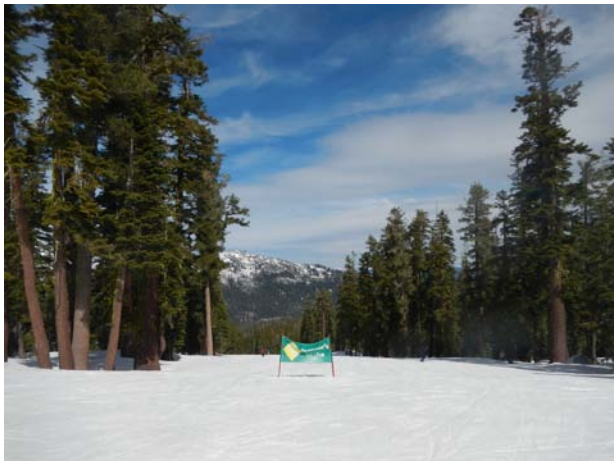
Wagon Wheel just above the "Steeps" (double fall line with slope dipping forward and to right).



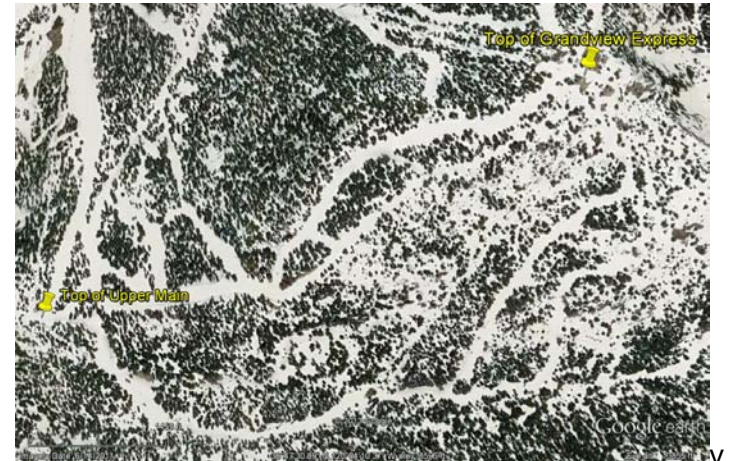




The Alley feature park from the Short Stuff Lift.

Top part of Marmot steep section. Pyramid Peak in the distance.



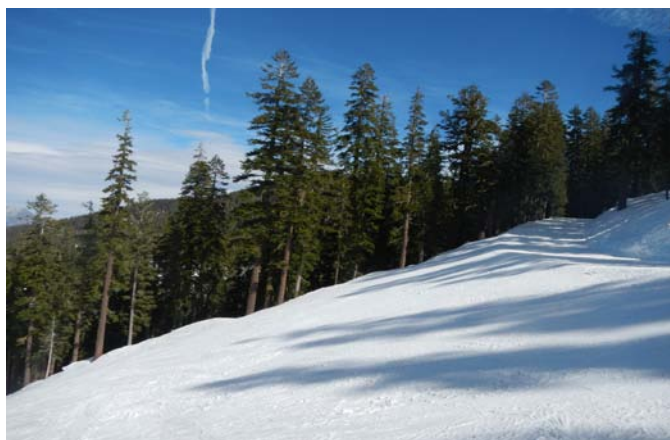
Marmot slopes where it meets Bryan Road (a work road) leading from Parking Lot A to West Bowl Base

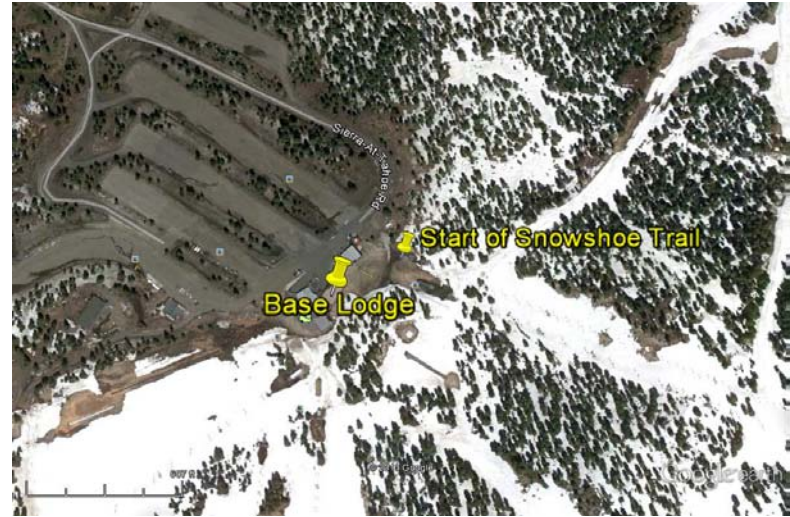
